250 Ways To Make Money

THE GOODS

If you are ever googled [“extra ways to make money”](#) you know there are seriously over a million ways (108,000,000 at my last check) to make extra money. It is hard to look at this because most of the time, you just glance over the list and not really know how to put the ideas into motion. Well I am going to change that.

This is not your typical list of ways to make money. It is a list, but off of EVERY way to make money, I am going to give you ideas and methods to use to make money in that way. What I want to achieve, is have you go down the list, starting with 1 and going till the end, and one by one try each and every one!

If you end up liking one way more than others, or if you end up making money on a specific idea, highlight it, circle it, do whatever you need to do to know that it worked for you. You WILL find a way to make extra money with this list, if you actually put it into action.

Which brings me to my next point: Nike created a slogan that is probably one of the best slogans ever. "JUST DO IT". That is what you need to do with this book. Just Do It. Reading how to make money is great, but will NOT make you money. Actually taking an item, and putting it into action, JUST DOING IT, is what is going to make you money. And if it makes you money, do it more often and it will make you more money. I have set up this book to help you do just that. I have not only given you the way, I have given you the method. One by one, try each and every item in this book. Put it into action. If it works, do it again and again and again. If it doesn't, move down the list. You will find something that you like.

Now, I understand that you will not be able to do EVERYTHING on this list. If you are allergic to dogs, being a dog walking is not realistic. But this list is so large, I can almost guarantee you will find something to make money. Some are online. Some aren't. Some are simple. Some aren't. Some will make you a lot of money. Some will make a few cents.

Before we get into the methods. I want you to get into the right mindset. This may be a little corny, but VERY helpful. Remember these things as you do these.

- Money is Money is Money. Whether you make .15 cents or 15 grand.

The idea behind this book isn't to make you a millionaire (although it

would be great if you did!). It is to make you a few extra bucks every month, every day, to help with your bottom line.

- Saving money is just as good as making money. Most of this list is ways to make money, but there are a few items where you will save money, which is still putting money into your pocket.
- NEVER PAY TO MAKE MONEY!!! None of the ideas listed in this book will charge you. If you have to sign up for anything, make sure it is a free sign up. Paying someone to get access to all these sites when you can get the same access and sign up for free is not a good way to make money. You CAN buy resources to help you along, but actually having to PAY to make money to access something is not a good way to increase your profit.
- JUST DO IT! You can read all the eBooks and resources you want on how to make money, but reading won't make you a dime! You actually have to go do it. As stated before, this book not only gives you the method, it gives you the steps you need to take in order to achieve those ideas and make money. You should go one by one and try each and every idea here. One will catch. JUST DO IT.

So here we go! This is a vast list and can be overwhelming. It is not the

type of book that you read all the way through front to back. Like I said earlier, if you just read this book, it will never make you money. But if you read this each idea, then go out and attempt it, then this book is the best value for your money. You don't have a time limit on this book. Reading it fast will not make you more money. I highly *HIGHLY* suggest you read each idea one by one. After you read one, go attempt to do it. If you like it and do well, come back and try something else while continuing to make money. If you fail, come back and try another one (failing is part of the learning process so don't EVER get down). If you read something and you just will never be into it, skip it.

NOW FOR THE LIST!

1. **Sell you stuff on craigslist:** Yeah, I am starting with the typical "SELL YOUR STUFF TO MAKE MONEY" bit. But truth be told it works. Walk around your house and look for items that you know you don't use anymore. There is someone on craigslist that is willing to pay you money for that item. 3 clicks and 4 lines, you have an ad on craigslist. It is not hard, and the reward is great. 2. **Sell other peoples stuff on craigslist:** You only have so much stuff around your house that you can sell. You don't want to sell EVERYTHING. So after you purge your house, go to your friend's house. Tell them you will give them a cut of what you make. Most of the time, the friend is going to say "naw, I don't need the money, just get rid of it for me" then you profit even more.
3. **Sell FREE stuff back on craigslist:** There is a section on craigslist where people can post stuff they are giving away for free. Some of the stuff is actually pretty good. If you can get something for free, then turn around and flip it on craigslist, you are making good extra money. There is an eBook out that shows how exactly to go about finding product, listing it, and other aspects of selling on craigslist. Check out our [Craigslist Page](#) for a video on how to search for free items on craigslist.
4. **Sell on eBay:** Craigslist is a great way to sell stuff locally. If you want a bigger playing field, go to eBay. You get people from around the world looking at your item. There are more logistics to go with eBay, but the payoff could be greater as well. Signing up is easy. Do the same thing as craigslist (find stuff around your house) set up your eBay and paypal account and start selling. Check out our [eBay resource page](#) on our website for more information.

5. **Buy and flip on eBay:** To do this, you need one of the most basic principles every created in business: Buy low, sell high. To flip stuff on craigslist, you need to do just that. Buy something VERY low on eBay, and resell it for a higher price. Here is how I do: Head on over to a site like [Missing Auctions](#). What this site does, is whatever you type it, it misspells the word and returns eBay auctions where the person putting the item on eBay misspelled the title. If the item is misspelled, it will not get near as many hits as if it were spelled correctly. You get crazy cheap product where you can turn around and sell for high.
6. **Become an EBay Assistant:** Once you master eBay, make money by setting other people up on eBay. eBay itself will send you people who need help with their complicated system. And you can charge them a commission.
7. **Offer article writing service for websites:** You know how to type. You have a computer. If you don't, learn how to type and go to a library to use a computer. Talk to companies that put articles online and start writing articles for different websites. Find a website for something that you are passionate about. Contact the company and you will write 500-750 word articles for \$5 an article. I know it isn't a lot of money, but the idea here is VOLUME!

8. **Sell stuff on eBay using "buy it now":** By enabling the buy it now functionality of EBay, you can get a quick sale. You do not have to wait the 7 days or whatever the auction is now. It could be a great way if you have a good product to ensure you will pull a profit, and make a quick sale.
9. **Wash cars around your neighborhood:** \$10/car-Washing cars are easy. They take 30 mins? As for \$10 a car that is like \$20 an hour. It really is easy money. Plus you can get enough "clients" to cycle and consistently pull a good amount of money in every single week. Plus you can work on your tan. :)
10. **Offer to clean a house:** Like the example above, cleaning houses really does not take that long. Our cleaning gal cleans our house in about 2 hours and we pay her \$80 a month. At \$40 an hour, that isn't a bad paying gig. And, like above, you can get a set of clients and create a nice little solid income stream for yourself. You can even specialize and only clean houses on the weekends, leaving you open for your 9-5 and you make good money on the side. Or offer a vacation cleaning. You can tell people that while they are on vacation, you can go take care of all the things around the house like cleaning up, watering plants and such and ensure that when the family comes home, they can come home to a nice

clean house!

11. **Offer to do yard work:** People want to have a nice clean yard, but most people don't want to do it. Put a little ad in the paper, buy a little lawn mower and trimmer and start making money. As you build clients, branch out and get more tools and learn how to do more. You can go from just cutting grass to trimming shrubs, to trimming trees then finally finish about with outright landscaping.
12. **Ask friends to spot you a few bucks:** Never underestimate the power of mooching. But be careful. Do it too much and you will be labeled as a mooch, which is never a good thing. Just forget a wallet here, be \$5 short there. Very gentle with this one.
13. **Write an eBook:** People are always looking for the easy way to get something done. An electronic, or "e" book is a book that people can buy, download as a PDF and read on their computer (such as you are doing now). Anyone can now be a published author. You can write about anything and everything! Sports, weight loss, fitness, dogs, boats, planes, trips, ANYTHING! Chances are if you are passionate about a subject, there are plenty more people around the world who will pay you for your book. And getting the book in their hands is easy! Check out our [eBook resource page](#) for more information.

- 14. Start an eBook writing business:** You know a lot about something, don't you? Dogs, cats, animals, sports, wood working.. anything. Write what you know in a little book, head over to [clickbank](#) or [paydotcom](#) and get yourself an account. Convert your word document with your how-to on it to a PDF. Buy a \$10 cheap domain (even a .net or .info domain). Watch the money roll in as people pay you for your information. Again, for the sake of keeping this eBook somewhat reasonable in length, I [have created a resource page](#) on our website.
- 15. Play an instrument at the park for a few hours and make donations:** You'd be surprised how giving people actually are. Plus, think of the possibilities that could happen. Who knows who is watching you? A big record label, some guy who knows a guy. It could be a great opportunity. If not, you make a few bucks doing something that you love.
- 16. Domain flip:** Just like flipping a house in real estate. Find good domains. Buy them. Then find a seller that will pay you more than what you paid for the domain. I usually use [GoDaddy](#) and [nametumbler](#) to find domains. [GoDaddy](#) sucks at hosting services, but if just want a place to hold a domain, you cannot beat them. Between their parking, forwarding and DNS abilities, they are by far the best. [NameTumbler](#) is a great way to find domains. Check out our videos on our [web hosting resource page](#)

on go daddy and name tumbler.

17. **Freelance:** This is a very BROAD category. I will cover more specific freelancing opps in the future. For now, freelance is basically being your own boss. You go out and find jobs, do the work, and get paid. Kind of like a contract employee, but not really. Writing, website design, data entry, personal assistant, you name it, you can freelance it. Personal assistant anyone can do. You just type, transcribe and other stuff. We'll cover more later.

18. **Virtual Assistant:** A virtual assistant is where you get paid to do virtual task for people who just don't want to do them. Like a regular assistant, most of the jobs are doing things like word processing, data entry, excel spreadsheets, pretty much anything a normal assistant would do, minus the BS tasks like getting coffee. There are 2 ways you can get virtual assistance gigs. One way is to look on craigslist for people who are looking for assistants. Don't look in just your local area. Look anywhere and everywhere. Find someone who wants an assistant and email them what you can do and your price range. The idea is your price, since you are virtual, will be less than someone who is actually in the office. The other way is to sign up for freelance sites such as [odesk](#), [guru](#), and [freelance switch](#), and sign up under that category. Then you can look at

freelance jobs of people who are specifically looking for a virtual assistant.

19. Get Paid To...Sites: There are sites that you normally get spammed to you. Most of spam. However, there are a few companies are legitimately paying people like you to do stuff for them. The next few suggestions are going to be different paid to sites and how to use them to make money. Some are REALLY easy. Others are a little more difficult to make money. But all the ways I will show you will actually make you money if you apply them. You can get paid to send emails, surf the web, shop, write, a whole bunch of thinks. Check out our complete list of GPT sites on our [GPT resource page](#).

20. NICHE IT!: Find a niche product, search for a high member ezine with low cost ads for this niche and promote the product. It usually produces some quick sales if you choose a good product. You need to try to be the guru of your niche. Think of something that you really enjoy or you think you truly know a lot about. Want to make even more money?? See Below:

21. Create your own Niche Product: This is another method from above. The above method wants you to find someone else's product and sell it for a commission of the sale. Well if you create your own product on a

niche field, you keep all the profits. Make sure you create your product on a platform such as clickbank so you can use all their affiliates.

22. Go to a casino: Blackjack. Poker. Slots. Whatever you wish. Like it or not, the casinos have made some people very rich. But please remember everything in moderation and moderation in everything. The casino can make you rich, but it can take all your money as well. There are even online casinos that you can hit. For different sites where you can gamble online, check out our [online casino resource page](#).

23. Create web templates and sell them. Do you have HTML experiences? This is a great way to make money. Create a few templates, zip them up and charge someone \$50 in paypal to buy them. People are looking for website templates all the time. The best thing for you is that this is something that you do once, and keep profiting over and over again. Spend \$10 and buy something like yournamewebtemplates.com. Put the zip file behind a NO INDEXED page that people can only get when they buy it. Have your pay pal receipt include the URL that has your no indexed link. The page has a link that says "DOWNLOAD ME" and your customer can download your templates. You don't do anything except watch the money roll in. Everything is an autopilot. Nice huh? Don't have HTML experience? You can either hire someone to create your

templates, or purchase a product like DREAMWEAVER, which is a drop and drop web design program that allows anyone to become a web designer.

24. **Paid Surveys:** Again, this is another one that you probably get spammed on and again, most are spam. But there are a few places out there that legitimately pay you for taking surveys. Please remember that you should never pay to make money. Sites that you have to pay for access are scams. You can sign up directly with the sites. All those pays sites are is someone bundling up the sites and charging you for something that if you do your research, can get for free. I have given you a few places to sign up above. Check out our [survey resource page here](#).

25. **Sell eBooks on Digital Point:** [Digital point](#) is a great place to find resources for selling and designing stuff on the web. Writing an eBook is a great way to make money. I know you have information in your head that you can get out. You must have a hobby, or be an expert about something, or have a good job that you can write about (SEE #13). Now that you have an eBook, there is a place on digital point where you can sell it. Digital point is a place where a lot of people go to look for different resources. The site gets a TON of traffic. If you have an eBook that can give people a resource for something, people WILL buy it. It is

free to sign up as a member of the forum board (which I recommend anyways because it is such a great resource). The only think you need to make sure is that you post the book in the right board. Digital point didn't become one of the best forum boards by people posting whatever wherever on the board.

26. Sell eBooks on [clickbank](#): This should be the FIRST place you try to sell your eBook. [Clickbank](#) not only has the easiest way to sell eBooks by taking care of EVERYTHING! Buy you also get access to their affiliate network. An affiliate is someone who sells your eBook for a set commission that you set up. And if you are thinking that you don't want people to take a commission of your sale, think again! Yes, you do lose a little bit of the sale to the commission, but the shear volume of people that will be seeing your product is worth losing a measly 10-50% off your commission. The more percentage you offer, the more people you will get to sell your product, the higher the volume you will sell. There is a magic number of what to charge your eBook for vs. what you sell your commission to ensure that you get a maximum profit for your product. I don't know what the number is. It depends on what you are selling, how much you are charging, and a great other number of things.

27. Sell eBooks on eBay (thumb drive or CD): EBay has new rules and

regulations and you CANNOT sell electronic products on eBay anymore. But that doesn't mean you cannot sell your items on eBay. You have to outthink eBay. One way you can do this is to burn your eBook onto a CD. Blank CD's are not that expensive and are very quick to burn. Now you are selling a physical product. Another way to overcome not selling electronic products is to print the book out, bring it (or even three hole punch and put into a binder) and mail it out that way. Again, now you have a physical product you can sell.

28. **Ewhoring:** This one may not be for everything. It is a great way to make money if you do it right. It is based off of pay per action programs. What PPA programs do is give you money for getting someone to sign up for a certain program. So ewhoring is signing up for a company such as a porn site, or a dating site and get people to sign up. So how it works is you sign up, and get a specific link to your sign up portal. Then go to the personal section of craigslist and put in an ad or reply to ads. Tell them you found this great site they should try out. The sign up through your link and you get a set amount of money. Porn sites pay the most by far (close to \$60-\$100). Dating sites pay 20-50 maybe more if you find a good program. Do your research, get creative and the money will come. I know I have said this before, but never pay to sign up for the programs.

Most legitimate companies will give you the link for free. If you have to pay for it, you don't want to work with them anyways. I personally tried this a few times. I had great success, but am greatly against the porn industry so I stopped.

29. **Build a list:** If you have a big list of emails that people subscribe, you can send them different offers where if they sign up, you get a certain commission (we talked about this earlier). There are so many stipulations on how to host a list, so make sure to read. [Aweber](#) is the best list provider. EVER. [Mailchimp](#) is good too. Mailchimp offers a free account..which is even better.
30. **Provide services:** Anything can be a service. Type up term papers. Go do someone grocery shopping. Do personal training. There are literally THOUSANDS of services you can offer. Need ideas? Head to craigslist. They have a service section you can check out. Find something that think you can do, put your own spin on it and post it on craigslist.
31. **Rent out empty rooms:** You can do this if you rent an apartment, or own your own home. If you have an extra room, you can rent it out and make a consistent monthly income. Craigslist is a great place to start. People in your area are posting all the time looking for an extra room.
32. **Rent out RV's:** Do you own an RV? If so, you probably do not use it

EVERY weekend. Why not rent it out to families that want to go on vacation? You can bundle a package deal that includes the RV for a set number of days (rent out X about of dollars a day) plus a deposit, PLUS a free driving lesson for those people who have never driven an RV before.

33. **Rent out a room or couch for a special event:** If there is a big event in your area, you can charge a flat fee for someone to stay in your room or even on your couch. I did this when comic-con was in San Diego. It is quite an easy way to make money. People aren't looking for accommodations. They just want a place to crash. Get in and get out.
34. **Return items:** You know that shirt in your closet that you bought last week. Yeah, you know the one you THINK you may wear one day. Do you really need that collecting dust in your closet? Go back and return it. You will get money in your pocket and room in your closet.
35. **Follow the basics:** Get an education. [Get a job.](#) Save 10%. Invest. Reinvest. Rinse repeat. Easy right? Yeah, but where is the fun in that?
36. **Get a well paying job:** I put only because it is a viable option to make money. It is one of those "DUH" ones. If you had a [well paying job.](#) would you really be looking at this book? No. This is one of the hardest things to do on this list, mainly because you need to get a degree, or a high certification to make a ton of money.

37. **Get good tax advice:** Rebates to drive a Prius? Returns for your Dog? If you get a good tax guy, you will be getting HUGE breaks on your [taxes](#). There are rebates, deductions and returns for just about anything. Find [someone](#) who is very knowledgeable, and save a LOT of money.
38. **Day labor:** Ever driven behind your local home depot and seen a slew of people just standing around? They want someone to drive by, pick them up and pay them for doing work. You can do this too (only without the standing around). Post an ad on craigslist that you are a hard worker and you know how to do item A, item b, ETC. Set your price and watch as people book you left and right. You need to realize that people are lazy by nature. You are one of the few people who are willing to work to get ahead. Don't think you are? Why did you buy this book then?
39. **Street performer:** Play an instrument, paint, sing, dance, tell jokes, do a puppet show. There are so many things you can do as a street performer. Find a high tourist place and watch the tips roll in. Be aware though: Some places require a permit to be a street performer. So check it out before you do it.
40. **Panhandler:** A panhandler is a person who depends on the spontaneous charity of strangers for their survival. If you really need the cash, you might swallow your pride and decide to ask for help. Make a sign, find a

good location, ask politely for money, and say thank you. Surprisingly, if you don't look homeless and have a clever sign of why you are standing on the corner, you could do pretty well. Stand on the corner of a high-end store. You know the people rolling into the parking lot have a lot of cash.

41. **Cyber Begging:** Cyberbegging is becoming increasingly popular, and there have been some amazing success stories, but these are the exception rather than the rule. While there are some sites on which you can beg just by putting up a brief ad, if you're looking to make any substantial money you'll probably have to build your own site and invest the time and money into it to make it successful.
42. **Donate plasma:** Donating your plasma actually pays a decent amount. Google "Donate my plasma" then your zip code to find a place around you.
43. **Donate Sperm:** This one creeps people out a bit. You will be a father, but indirectly. If you are up for it, it could be a nice way to supplement your income. Do the same search as the plasma.
44. **Donate eggs:** SEE ABOVE
45. **Recycle:** Not just your own cans. Tell your neighbors that you will recycle theirs. Go to the park and (with some heavy duty gloves) go

through trash cans and get the recycle out. I know some hippies who do this to try to save the world, but they make between \$100 and \$200 dollars extra every month!

46. Open a lemonade stand: Who doesn't want a nice cup of lemonade!

Want to really make a killing doing this? Hire the cutest little girl you can to do your dirty work. Tell her if she sells your lemonade, you will give her a commission of all the gross sales. I am kidding. Go find a kid that you know, talk to their parents and tell them it would be a great way for little jimmy to learn how to world works. You make money. Little jimmy does the work and gets a lesson on how the world runs.

47. Enter sweepstakes: Someone has to win it right? Enter enough, why not your name gets drawn? There are some great sites where you can track different sweepstakes and such. You can get crazy about it or you can do it casually. Someone wins. It should be you. Pay offs are not frequent, but they are big.

48. Become a moving advertisement (car, tee-shirts, temp tats):

Companies are always looking for different ways to get their name out there. If you can do a little creative thinking, and approach the company in the right way, you could make out very nicely. Here is one example: Find a guy (or gal) who can make killer decals for car windows. Go to an

auto glass repair company and tell them you have a great idea that you are willing to advertise for them. Have the decal guy create a decal that makes the glass look shattered, with text that says "Oops...Now I need to go to AJ's Window Service" or whatever the company is. Tell the company that they if they pre pay for 3 months of advertisement, you will give them a free month. Tell them you will drive X number of hours in X number of places for X amount of dollars each month. They sign up, cut you a check, you put the decal on and just drive around. Money Money Money. Think outside the box. Use tee shirts, temporary tattoos, cars, boats, RVs, think of some way to advertise, think of a clever way to advertise, approach the company and make money.

49. Join Project payday: Project payday is a get rich quick scheme. It really is. You are going to visit the site and hear countless ways to make money using project payday. It is a scam...as a get rich scheme. You will not make fast money (well you could, but you will have to be extremely good at what you do. Project payday IS a great way to make a few extra bucks here and there. Sign up here, read how to make money, then when you get a few minutes here, or a few minutes there, make a few bucks here and a few bucks there.

50. Etsy: Etsy is a place where you can sell homemade product. If you can

sew, build, or mold anything, you should be selling on Etsy. For example, my wife just learned how to sew. She only knows how to sew one thing: Pajama pants. She is learning more, but for now, it is just pajama pants. But she can make killer pajama pants. She sits on the couch, while we are watching TV, and sews her pants. Then I take the pants and sell them on Etsy. Every single pair of pants have sold. So we build on it and tell our customers they can choose their own pattern and we will custom make the pants. So now, using her basic knowledge of pajama pants, we own our own etsy store selling custom made PJ pants. If you know how to make birdhouses, ceramic cake toppers, pantyhose, whatever-you should be selling on etsy. If you don't know how to make, sew, mold or building something, LEARN! Like I said, my wife has only been sewing for about a month at the time of writing this book, but she has perfected the art of pajama pants. Get really good at one thing and start selling. Once you have the time, branch off and learn something else.

51. Sell E-Products: An e-product is any product that is sold electronically.

It can be books, software, audios, newsletters, anything! The best thing about e-products is that you can streamline the whole process where you do the work only once and get paid over and over and over. First thing

you need to do is get a product. The best thing to do is to write an eBook. Pick any subject and write 5-15 pages in a word document. Make it easy to read, and information that someone would theoretically want to read. Then go to clickbank.com and sign up for an account. Fill in all your information. Go get a domain (.info and .biz domains are only like \$1.99. Small investment for what you could earn) Put your website template on your domain. Put your eBook on a no indexed page. Again, enter this information into clickbank. Activate your site and VOILA! You are done with the work FOREVER! A customer hits your site, clicks on the BUY NOW link, pays you for your product, gets directed to your thank you page which has your download and downloads your product. Clickbank handles the purchases, returns, issues, everything. All you have to do is cash the checks they send you every month.

52. Sell your photos: Sell personal exclusive rights. Different from Stock.

In today's day and age, everyone has a digital camera and takes photos of EVERYTHING! Have you ever taken that photo and thought it was really good? You can make money of that photo. Stock photos are places where people like you can put up their photos and other people can download them for their newsletters, websites, and other needs. The catch is, the people download must pay you a fee before they can

download it. NICE huh? And, like most of the things on this list, it is free to upload your photos. So even if no one ever buys any of your photos, you do not lose anything for trying. Check out [our photography resource page](#) for more information.

53. Small business web design: Thanks to technology, anyone can become a web designer. If you have spent any time online, you know what websites are easy to use, and which ones frustrate you. Go onto craigslist and find gigs that want to build you websites. Remember, you have hardly zero website building experience. USE THAT IN YOUR PITCH! Since you have no experience, you think outside the box. You know what consumers like because you are a consumer. You will be cheaper than anyone else. You will be fast than anyone else because you only take one job at a time. Make sure you under promise and over deliver. You may get follow up projects! Check [out our webhosting resource page](#) for more information.

54. Start a part time business from home: Anything really can be a part time home base business for you. Dog walking, window washing, yard work, whatever. Find something you can do effectively from out of your own home, put an ad on craigslist or even in the newspaper. Get a call. Do the job. Want to be more business like? Go to [vistaprint.com](#) and get

their free business cards for Joe's Dog Walking Service. Hand them out to customers or just to random people. The good word of how great you are will soon spread and you will have more work that you know what to do with. No matter what you are doing, [vista print](#) is a great place to get all your marketing material. DIRT CHEAP!

55. Get a part time job: Simple and obvious. I have a 9-5. But I use to work part time 7pm-1:30am twice a week at \$12 an hour to supplement my income. My part time gig is an easy job. I am low man on the totem pole and have no reason to move up. I punch in, work, get paid, and leave. That is all I want and that is all I do. If you are looking for a sure fire way to put extra cash into your wallet, a part time job is the way to go. A part time job is a great place for you to do something you actually enjoy. Most people settle for their full time job because it pays the bills. A part time job, really go for something you enjoy! And since you are not worried about climbing the corporate ladder, you can actually enjoy it.

56. Rent your house: This is a tricky numbers game, but can work nicely. Let's say you purchases a 2 bedroom 2 bath, 1200 Sq foot house. You own it. You pay a mortgage of \$1000 every month. Place an ad on craigslist with pictures of your house for rent for \$2000. If you get hits, go to the houses for rent section and see if you can rent another house for

\$1000 or less. The cheaper you can rent another house, the more money you will make. So now, the money you are getting on you renting your house is not only paying for your mortgage, it is paying for your new house rental too! You have no more payments. Again, you aren't making money, but not having a mortgage or rent payment is HUGE if you ask me. Make sure you do your research. Craigslist is an easy way to do market research as it is free to post an ad. If you get a lot of hits, take the next step. The nice thing about this one too is that you are the landlord. If you don't think this is working, as long as you give your tenant proper notice, you can kick em out!

57. **Babysit:** Parents, especially new ones, are always looking for someone trust worth worthy to keep an eye on their little ones while they go have a night out. This is easy to get gigs by using craigslist, both posting and finding.

58. **Collect change:** This is one of little extra cash. But it really adds up. I just cashed in the change that I collect over a year and it ended up being close to \$175. That is just from throwing loose change and change I found into a jar and taking the jar to one of those kiosks that spit out the cash. Quite easy money that way.

59. **Medical tests:** Outside from donating sperm, plasma and your eggs,

there are even further medical test you can sign up for. These are things like new drugs that hit the market and such. If you qualify, you take the drugs and tell them if you die or not (kidding). You inform them of the good, the bad and the ugly. These types of studies actually pay pretty well. Being a "virtual lab rat" is quite easy and most of the time you can do everything out of your house and never have to visit an office. If you just Google "Medical Test in (ZIP CODE)" you will find plenty of hits. Like most everything else, make sure you do your research. You don't want some random person and random place performing medical tests.

60. **Scalp tickets:** Of course, scalping is illegal. So flipping tickets it what we are going to call it. This is done just like eBay or craigslist. Buy low and sell high. Keep tabs on how a certain concert or show is doing. If you think it is going to be huge, buy tickets early, and sell them late. You will pull a HUGE profit. Sign up for places like Ticketmaster and [stub hub](#) and get early notices and even early access to concerts. I just did this with Taylor Swift and Blink-182 and make a *profit* of \$475 together. Not bad money!! You don't have to buy expensive seats (although people pay better money for those).

61. **Offer coaching online:** Yes, you can be the next Tony Robbins in your niche! You know something every well. Everyone does. Whether that is a

hobby, job, or something you were taught, you know something more than the next person (we already talked about this a bit in the eBook section). And people want to learn it. Think how you can package up your knowledge into a coaching plan. Something like an eBook, email support and 1 free phone call on how to and BAM! you are an online coach! Think of your package, bundle it up, charge via pay pal and you have your online coaching business.

62. Start a Referral business: I love craigslist. So many people are on there posting stuff it is great. But sometimes, people miss each other. Bring people together with a referral business on craigslist. There are many ways you can do this: Connect jobs with resumes. Connect buyers and sellers. Connect women with men. Connect men with men. Connect women with women. Connect baby sitter to family. ANYTHING! And how you get paid is charge a low flat rate. Have the person pre pay and if you don't find someone within X amount of days, you will refund the money. Paypal is great for this. Paypal allows you to easily collect, and return money frequently.

63. Free Trials/Cash Incentives: This one is another tricky numbers game. Many times, places offer "Sign up for a free trial, get \$100". But the catch is that a free trial really means 1 month free, and auto charge for the

second month and so on. These offers are great if you actually follow through and cancel the plan. I recently got a free iPhone from doing this. You had to complete all the surveys and such, and even buy a product. But I spend a total of \$12.95 (shipping and handling for trials) and got the free iPhone (3gs baby!!). After I got the phone I just cancelled all the offers. So I basically got a \$600 phone for \$12.95. Not a bad deal if you as me!! Just make sure you cancel. Bank accounts and credit cards do these too. Get \$25 for opening an account. I am in the process of creating a HUGE LIST of these freebie type sites. The page will be <http://250waystomakemoney.com/freebies>. Keep checking back on that page.

64. Write site reviews: If you don't know anything about SEO, here is a little bit of info: One way website rank high is to have links on other sites. So if you approach a company and tell them you will write reviews on their site in forum boards and blog posts comments and included a link for X amount of dollars. Then gather all the information you can about the company, and write a 500-700 word story on the company and go to forum boards and comment on blogs and include the link. Then, just to go above and beyond, make a list off all the sites and send them to the boss man, just to know they are getting something for their money.

65.Design Logos: You are a consumer. You have seen logos that you know they are amazing, and you have seen others that just fall flat. Most logos are just decorative text. So if you know how to use clip art, you can create logos. If you want to have even more effects, [download and learn how to use photoshop](#). Photoshop is a hefty investment, but treat it like an investment to ensure that it will pay off. Don't want to drop 300 bones on software, check out [GIMP](#). It is a free photo/editing software that is free. It has most of the same functionalities of [photoshop](#) in a different interface and without the \$300 price tag. It is a little tougher to learn, but for those of you who cannot get a \$300 software, it is not a bad deal.

66.Sell art online: Can you draw or paint? Do you know someone who can? Why not take your art, or someone else's art and frame it and see if you can sell it on eBay or something. And remember that investment you made in [photoshop](#) in #65? Why not take a tutorial and learn how to create computer art. Now you really are using [photoshop](#) as an investment.

67.Write and sell code: Whether the code is for a website, a web application, a desktop application or anything else, people will pay good money for exclusive rights to your code. Now there are other ways to make money off of code too instead of exclusive rights. You rent it out to

other coders to add to it. You could sell it and take a part of ongoing commissions. I recommend outright selling it through. You can make more money, then just code something else.

68. Become an online tutor: If you are educated in anything (even kindergarten!) people will pay you to tutor them, or their kids. Any subject, any grade level you will be able to find someone who wants a tutor. And tutoring can be as easy as watching a kid do their homework! Post an ad on craigslist and list the areas that you know. People will contact you, set up payment a VOILA. MONEY.

69. Virtual Landlord: You can move merchandise online without paying rent on a warehouse. Just play virtual landlord and charge other retailers monthly fees (or per-transaction fees) for the opportunity to market their products on your site. Amazon.com nabbed 28% of its revenues this way in 2006. Craigslist is another take on this model: The 25-person company charges businesses to post help wanted ads in San Francisco, New York and L.A., and also collects fees for apartment listings in New York City. (Total page views per month: about 5 billion.)

70. Virtual matchmaker: EBay runs online auctions and takes a cut of the final selling price. Other marketplaces simply charge buyers and sellers monthly fees for easy access to each other. Most are niche plays.

Examples: Mfg.com matches equipment manufacturers with smaller component suppliers, while H2Bid.com links municipalities with wastewater-equipment vendors. So you can find something to specialize in, and connect them!

71. Content Provider: If you create truly valuable content, you should be able to charge for it, right? Targeted newsletters and pornography sites can, some yielding operating margins of 30% and higher; many other media outlets resort to selling advertising (see next slide). Dating sites like Match.com--a cross between a subscription-based content provider and a virtual marketplace--charge subscription fees for access to their members.

72. Job Connector: Connect employers with prospective employees, many of whom are already employed and not actively job-hunting, via networking - the people who know these qualified candidates. Rewards for referring a candidate who gets hired range from \$50 on up to several thousand dollars - not chump change. If you know a lot of job-seekers (and who doesn't these days?), this is a great way to break into the recruiting business with no overhead.

73. Connect Suppliers with Buyers: Referral fees are a common practice in business, but they haven't been used much in online

networking sites because there was no way to track them. Vendors set the referral fees they're willing to pay (and for what), and when the transaction happens, you get paid. uRefer also allows merchants to set up referral programs for introductions and meetings, as well as transactions. You are basically an independent job consultant!

74. Write, Write, And Write: A growing number of sites will pay for your articles or blog posts. [Associated Content](#) and [Helium](#) will "pay for performance" based on page views for just about anything you want to write about. Articles on specific topics they're looking for can earn direct payments up to about \$200. The rates are probably low for established writers, but if you're trying to break into the field and have time on your hands, they're a great way to start. Plus, if you are running a website or a blog, it is a great place to link too.

75. Start your own blog: You don't have to have your own Web site, or install blogging software, or even figure out how to set up the advertising. At Blogger.com, you can set up a blog for free in less than five minutes without knowing a thing about web design, and Blogger even automates setting up Google AdSense so you can make money off your blog by displaying ads and getting paid when people click on the ads. To make even more money from it, set up an affiliate program for

books, music, etc., ([sign up at amazon](#)) and insert your affiliate links whenever you refer to those items. You'll have to get a lot of traffic to become [a six-figure blogger](#), but pick an interesting topic, write well, tell all your friends, and you're off to a good start.

- 76. Create topical resource hubs:** Are you an expert on a particular niche topic? Of course you are. We already discussed this more than once. You can put together an overview of the topic and assemble some of the best resources on the topic from around the web. Then you can create topical hubs and get paid through sites like [Squidoo](#), [HubPages](#) and [Google Knol](#). Payments are based on a combination of ad revenue and affiliate fees. You'll get higher rates doing it on your own, but these sites have a built-in supply of traffic and tools to make content creation easier.
- 77. Advertise other people's products:** If you already have a Web site or a blog, look for vendors that offer related but non-competing products and see if they have an affiliate program. Stick to familiar products and brands - they're easier to sell. To promote those products, do the following: Place simple text or graphical ads in appropriate places on your site. Include links to purchase products you review or recommend in a blog, discussion forum or mailing list you control. Create a dedicated sales page or Web site to promote a particular product. They all work - it

just depends on how much time you have to spend on it and your level of expertise with Web design and marketing.

78. Make money using Amazon: Amazon has a program called amazon associates. Basically, you get a unique link for your amazon page and everything you sell through amazon via your link, you get a certain commission. Amazon has anything and everything on their site. So this can be as easy as telling family members you know of this great product they could use for X scenario. Send them the link and BAM you get paid for just recommending a product. Easy money, right?

79. Microstock photography: You don't have to be a professional photographer to sell your photos for money. People are constantly in need of stock photography for websites, presentations, brochures and so on, and are willing to pay for the right image. People generally search for images on stock photography sites by keywords, not by photographer, so you have the same chance as anyone else of having your image picked. Just be careful that you don't have images of trademarked brands, copyrighted art or people's faces that are readily identifiable (unless you have a model release), but just about anything else is fair game, and I promise - you'd be amazed what people need pictures of, so don't make any assumptions. If it's a decent photo, upload it. Some sites to get you

started include [Fotolia](#), [Shutterstock](#), [Dreamstime](#) and [iStockphoto](#). The great thing about this is that it's truly "set it and forget it". Visit our [stock photo resource page](#) for a complete list off all the best stock photo sites. Sign up to all of them. Upload your photos to all of them. Make money from all of them. Also on the page, there is another great how to sell your stock photography guide, free to you since you purchase this eBook. It has more in depth ways of making money using stock photography like which photos sell the best, what key words to use, and what people really are looking for on those sites. Again, it is a free bonus for purchasing this book.

80. **Bartending:** No matter the economy, people will always go to the bar. NO MATTER WHAT. Learning how to bartend. Take a few classes, learn the drinks, add a little flair, be personable, and you are one of the better bartenders in your town. The better you are, the more tips you will make and that is where a majority of the money comes from.
81. **Crafting:** There are people out there that are too damn crafty. From scrapbooks, to sewing, to frame making, to jewelry making, there are people how there that just have knacks for creating items. If you are one of them, you can turn your crafting hobby into a money making business. Create sample products and either sell online at eBay or Etsy, or offline

at craft fairs and flea markets. In order to ensure that what you make gets sold, only take samples. Have people fill out order forms and pre pay for their item, *THEN* go and make it and mail it off to them. You will never have to sit on inventory and lose time and money when something doesn't sell.

82. Music Lessons: Do you play guitar? Piano? Violin? If you play any instrument, trade your time for training and money by teaching music lessons. Again, this is as easy as posting an ad on craigslist or your local paper. Tell them what instrument, your going rate, ETC. If you really want to make it into a business, create a package deal. If you normally charge \$50 a lesson, give 6 lessons for \$200. Or say buy 3 lessons, get 3 free. If you are worried about losing money, ramp up what you charge. If you normally charge \$40, package up the deal at \$50 an hour. You actually get a pay raise, and after a few classes, that extra \$10 pays for itself.

83. Organizer: I can't do this. I am not an organized person. I have my own organization and can for the most part find anything on my desk. People that are extremely organized scare me. But, if you are one of those people, you can actually make money by helping people like me. Everyone wants to be organized, but most people don't know how to

start. That is where you freaks...I mean highly organized people come in. Offer your services to organize people. Like all these ways to make money, you will make more money on something if you put your own spin onto it. For organizing, you can sell yourself by saying you WILL NOT fully organize the person. You will get them started on the right track, but you will let them finish it. This allows them to not only get organized, but also LEARN how to get organized so they can learn for the future. They won't learn. They will call you again. It is human nature NOT to pick up something up. But it is a different approach to something that has been done before. Since you are different, people will be apt to pay you over someone else.

84. Pet Sitter: This one is for all you animal lovers. Pet owners are always looking for a place where they can trust to leave their precious pooky at while they are at. If you are an animal lover, it will show in your initial meeting and you will have an instant customer. Have a safe, clean, gated house and people will feel good leaving their animal with you.

85. Call Center: This is a job you can do in the comfort of your own home. You set up your phone to ring when someone calls his or her call center. You are trained on what to say, and how to help the customer. You help them. You get paid an hourly wage most of the time. Some will pay you

per call. But no matter how you get paid, you still get paid. Check out [Alpine Access](#), [LiveOps](#), and [WestatHome](#). They are some of the best at home call centers.

86. Mystery Shopper: Despite what you may think from the countless spammers out there, mystery shopping is a legitimate way to make extra money. It is very simple, you sign up for a few valuable companies, they email you when there is shops in your area. You either go out to dinner, go buy something at a store, or go get a service done. You write up your report, they not only pay you, but also reimburse you for your cost. So basically you get a free shopping trip, free dinner and free oil changes (if those are the items you are doing for the company). Most people think that it is a scam because some people force you to pay for access. These are nothing more than Internet marketers trying to get money from you to access stuff you can get for free.

87. Cleaning Up Pet Droppings: This is the “shittiest” job on the this HUGE list, but it pays great if you don't mind the work. It is a well known fact people are lazy. And it is a well known fact that people don't like dog poop. People will pay good money to have you come to their yard and clean up their pet droppings. Again. use craigslist, post and ad, go buy a good shovel or a poop scooper and some gloves and you are

running your own business. Again, check out vista prints, think of a funny name for your business like Danny's Doggy DooDoo Service and hand out business cards.

88. Trapping or Hunting feral hogs: random, I know right? But you can actually make money doing this believe it or not! [Read about it here:](#)

89. Write for Associated Content: [Associated Content](#) is an ezine site that will pay you for posting articles. It isn't much, but if you have a popular article, you can make a good amount. Here is a tip: Write about current events. I wrote about Michael Jackson the day he died. The article took off and I ended up making a couple hundred dollars off of it. No one reads it now, but then, it was huge. Catch trends.

90. Start a membership site: I have said it a few times in this list and I am going to say it again: There has to be something that you are good at, or know more than the average Joe. I have already shown ways to create information products with your knowledge. Membership sites are another great way to make money. Put your information behind a portal and charge a monthly fee to access it. Even a low monthly fee is good money. \$7 a month x 100 monthly subscribers is \$700 a month. I know there is at LEAST 100 people that want your information. You just have to find them and convince them that your site has the information they are

looking for. Check out [our membership site resource](#) page and get more information.

91. Flip web domains: The dot com gold rush made many millionaires but there's still plenty of money in domain real estate and still some good catches available. A good dot com may be difficult to find now, but it still is possible. And there are always dot info and .net domains that you can take up. Put your thinking hat on, buy a famous word domain for a few dollars and put it up on the domain selling sites.

92. Buy and Sell Misspellings: Massive opportunities still exist in the misspelling/typo market. People trying to get elsewhere land on your site instead ... and you sell them stuff (or use the domain parking idea). Some even tempt fate by making PPC opportunities out of typo squatting on trademarks. Finding typos has never been easier. There are many tools that will find misspellings for you. How easy can it get?

93. Domain parking and type-in traffic: People sometimes guess at URLs. If they want a plumber they may try plumber.com though they've never used that site themselves. Find terms that people may be typing in (I will provide a detailed guide to this when I get a chance), buy the domain and populate it with ads. There are several ad programs to monetize your parked domains. Or combine this with the previous idea to buy

plummer.com or similar typo domains to make money online. Yes, you kind of are making money off of idiots, but you are at least making money, right?

94. Run a domain management service: Hundreds of thousands of webmasters (or more) have a large portfolio of domains. A lot of them would like the boring bit taken out of their domain management. You can run their DNSes or just a service reminding them when each domain comes up for renewal. Or an automated monitoring service to tell them when one of their domains/sites is inaccessible. You can even sign up as a domain reseller. This is more like a legitimate business, but is a very low key business that can make you a nice income. Sell 200 domains @ \$10 a year and you have an extra \$2000 a year. And 200 domains actually is not that much when you think of all the million domains you could possible sell. Another benefit is that most people will keep renewing the domain, so you will keep that \$2000 every year without hardly doing anything.

95. Run a domain research service: Wonder what happens when a manufacturer is looking to name a new model car? Or starting a new range of clothing? They need trademark and patent research but now they also need some domain research. Which of the literally thousands of

combinations and misspellings (+ <brandname>sucks.com) are taken and which do they need to buy? With a few of the free domain tools discussed on this page and one or two more - like free DNS tools - and a little time you could provide them a service they'd pay a lot of money for.

96.Site Flip: Site flipping doesn't require as much capital and expertise as many people believe. Like property flipping, you buy one that needs a bit of TLC. Do it up, then sell it on for a whacking great profit. And, the beauty is you never have to deal with tenants! How about cornering a little market? There are DMOZ categories with grandfathered sites (sites that have been listed for many years) that aren't being updated. If you can pick up a few sites in the same category and merge their content suddenly you "own" that niche. That opens a lot of possibilities.

97.Design CSS or HTML templates: Create designs (templates) and flog them. You can sell each one multiple times to webmasters who don't have the time or patience to get familiar with the intricacies and quirks.

98.Directories: start one. Webmasters pay to be listed in your directory. The better your directory the more you can demand. Basically, find a good domain like theverybestdirectory.com or something of that nature. Contact webmasters and tell them that you have a directory and for the low price of \$9.95/mo (or whatever you want to charge) they can be

listed there.

99. **CPA = Cost per Action:** CPA is where if you get someone to do something, you get paid. It comes in the form of sign ups, to sales, to email submits and countless other things. Whatever your niche is, there is a CPA offer for you. You can sign up at a CPA company (check out [our CPA resource page](#) for a list) and find an offer. I currently run one on a credit card site I have. I found an offer from a credit repair company where if I get people to sign up, they will give me \$30 per sign up. So I posted a banner ad on my website and currently make between \$90 and \$240 each month just because of that one CPA. And the best part is I did the work once, and now never have to worry about it. The CPA company just sends me a check every single month.

100. **Posting in Forums:** Like hanging out in forums and chatting to other people? Owners of new forums have a problem. If there aren't a lot of conversations going then people don't stop to talk. So they get the chat flowing by paying for posts. So, jump in, start chatting and get paid.

101. **BLOGGING:** Have expertise in a particular subject? Write regularly on that subject and give away your knowledge for free. People will bookmark your blog and visit regularly. The money is in allowing companies to advertise their products and services to your very eager

audience. There are third parties like [payperpost](#) handle the finding of advertisers. Don't have expertise in a particular subject? That doesn't stop bloggers. Some of them blog on the most mundane things - from what they had for breakfast to how they spent their day. And still the advertisers come. So just be passionate about something and the advertisers will follow.

102. **Myspace:** Even with twitter and facebook, myspace still has hundreds of millions of users. Create an account, get friends, find a CPA, or affiliate marketing product, or even your own product, and market to your friends using your comment board, blog board and update status.
103. **Facebook:** Create a fan page of something. This is one where you really should think outside the box since there are already a million fan pages on pretty much anything already out there. Think of something unique, something that is not take and create it. Get fans and market to them using your niche. Example, ultimate Frisbee. Create an ultimate Frisbee fan page and send Frisbee news to them, but throw in a link every now and then with your affiliate code attached and watch the money flow in. The more fans you have the more money you will make.
104. **Sell trinkets to myspace users.** They love them. Especially shiny ones. Myspace backgrounds, templates, animations, scripts, icons and

other "myspace resources" are a multimillion dollar industry. These are not hard to create and there are plenty of online tools you can use to create. Check out [webfetti and download their toolbar](#). It is basically a point and click toolbar to add fund stuff to a myspace account.

105. **Writing a newsletter.** Building a mailing list is a long term plan and it pays dividends but don't expect immediate results. If your newsletter is good and you promote it well you can collect hundreds of thousands of subscribers (who all get the newsletter for completely free). The more subscribers you have on your list the more advertisers pay to feature in your newsletter. In order to make money, you can either send out a regular newsletter for free and just put ad space, or affiliate links throughout the newsletter. Or send out more infrequent and charge per month for the newsletter if you have information in high demand. Or do both: For those people who don't want a free newsletter with ads, they can get the same information without the ads for a monthly price.

106. **Do Someone's Grocery Shopping:** There are elderly people who will pay good money to do this. Then you have the rich lazy people who will also pay. Get their list (via email), go get everything on the list, get reimburse for the groceries plus a fee. I would think that the fee would be commissioned based. The more groceries you get, the bigger the

commission. Plus, the more you shop, the better you will know the store, the faster you will get the shopping done.

107. **Be a researcher.** At places like answers.com people pay for you to go research an answer to questions they don't have time to answer themselves. Like, "How do I choose an SLR camera?" and "What's the name of the theme song to the TV program A Bit of Fry and Laurie?"
Note: Google has now closed the answers.google.com service but if you're that good at hunting things out you'll find that there are other places where people pay for answers. And, I'm not just talking paid homework help.

108. **Has someone has violated your online rights?** Perhaps they don't have a privacy page on their site as required by law. Or haven't made their site disabled friendly (illegal in some parts of the world). Sue them. Particularly if you can get one of those no win-no fee vultures to act for you. A guy called André-Tasha Lammé kept getting calls from salesmen selling him stuff. He sued them in the Sacramento, CA, small claims court (easy to do). Guess what? Apparently the law in the US awards you \$500 each time a telesales person makes an unwanted call to you. Lammé walked away with \$6,000. What's the law where you are? Worth looking into. Don't get me wrong, I am not in favor of suing everyone for

anything. But if you truly feel your rights have been violated, why not get something in return?

109. **Sell Celeb photographs:** Live in a big city? Hang around at celebrity watering holes, click some photos. There's always someone online willing to pay for interesting ones - there are sites specifically for the buying/selling of photos like these. Get "lucky" and click the UN Secretary General picking up a hooker and you can buy that dream home in the Bahamas quicker than he can say United Nations Secretary General. Find Paris Hilton in another compromising video and.... you can buy Microsoft. People will even buy your little photos of little celebrities if you find the right buyer.
110. **Exploit people's emotions:** We humans are emotional. We can't help it. There is something that will trigger an emotional response that will make us want to give money (like those starving kids in Africa commercials or the pet adoption commercials). So why not feed of the emotions? One story in particular, a guy threaten to eat his pet rabbit live online if he did not get enough money to pay his rent. Guess what...he paid his rent and then some and little fluffy was spared. You may not need to go so dramatic, but get creative and you will be able to think of a way. Think of something you are passionate about. Start with that and

build from there.

111. **Email SPAM.** Nobody likes it, it's illegal in some countries, ISPs get very upset, recipients get even more upset but no list of how people make money online can be complete without a mention of this. What do you sell when you spam? Have a look at what type of spam YOU are getting, it will likely give you an idea of what pays. And the stock tips that seem to "accidentally" land in your inbox. But that's about all the help I'm giving you on the subject.

112. **Hosting Reseller:** You don't need to buy a lot of server hardware to provide a web hosting service. Many big hosting companies allow "reseller" accounts where you sell hosting plans to customers and the hosting company will host them all for you under your Reseller account umbrella. You get to charge customers as much as you want. Some Resellers provide value added services and charge more for these. At places like WHT you'll find that resellers sometimes sell their customers as a "bundle" i.e., you can pay some money to buy a reseller "business". Related to the above is free hosting where you provide small website owners free hosting and in exchange you serve ads to all their pages to make the revenue to pay the hosting company and yourself. Early pioneers of this model are well known names like Geocities and

Angelfire. Like the domain one, people will buy hosting packages and almost always renew. So you will get a continual revenue stream coming in. I suggest looking at [Blue Host](#), [Host Gator](#), [Go Daddy](#), and [Webhosting Buzz](#). I use Host gator for my reselling, but I use blue host to host my own websites, Go Figure. Blue host is a better host, but host gator pays better.

113. **Be A Broker:** Being a broker can be done in a thousand different ways. There are some entrepreneurs making healthy profits just by bidding for projects on places like elance and guru (and others) and farming them out to a bank of writers/programmers they use on a regular basis. Or you can broker items on Craigslist. Or you can be a broker on eBay. Or a real estate broker. A broker is nothing but finding something, and showing it to someone else for a commission. That is how it works in real estate. Apply it to what you know and it will make you some nice extra cash on the side, especially if it is something that you know quite a bit about and are passionate about. It will show through in your presentations.

114. **Day Trading:** Trading from home is really catching on in many parts of the world. You don't need to be an expert on stocks & shares. You can trade on commodities, currencies, lots more. Trading futures allows you

to leverage even small \$100 amounts of capital into huge fortunes (or bankruptcy).

115. **Gambling** is a far cry from trading futures but a route to riches for many. Horseracing, football, baseball, poker, slots, whatever. Return can be big. Losses can be bigger.
116. **HYIP**, or High Yield Investment Programs are just what they say on the tin. They are also highly risky. You invests your money and you takes a chance, but some pay as much as 100% per day. How do they do it? A very few are putting your money into investments with even better rates of return. Others are simply going to keep paying out the first few customers with investments collected from later ones.... and then they go bust. Pyramid style. Maybe the ones who make the money are the ones who get in early... or actually start HYIP programs.
117. **Get paid for your unused computer cycles.** Is your computer sometimes on while you aren't actually sitting at it? Then it's using electricity but not performing "work". Joining a distributed computing group like SETI lets you use that computing power to help reach some worthy/unworthy goal. However, you can also use those cycles to earn money by selling them to companies who have large computing tasks then can't do completely in-house.

118. **Start a content site:** This is done by providing information to people and then putting up contextual ads up in the space. Find a very specific niche and go buy a good, specific domain. Set up the website with wordpress and install WP-matic plugin. This takes the RSS feeds of other blogs and automatically puts the content on your site. Throw up some YPN or Adsense ads and you have a content site on autopilot.
119. **Find Missing Money-**There maybe some money that you are owed by the government. Find your local branch of the controllers office and do a quick search for your first and last name. I found that my mom has close to \$2000 entitled to her after my grandparents passed. It is your money. Go get it.
120. **Cafepress-**Become an instant tee shirt designer! [Cafe press](#) is a great place where anyone can design tee shirts. You design it and put it up online. If someone buys it, you make money. If they don't, it doesn't cost you a thing! [Cafepress](#) takes a nice commission from your sale for the product and such, but who cares-It isn't costing you a thing! This is another thing to use to catch a fad. When Michael Jackson Died, I create a tee shirt that had MJ's face on a design that looked like Obama used in his campaign for Presidency with the red and blue colors. I put the text "ICON" at the bottom and had GREAT results. Watch for trends.

Celebrity freaks out? Make a shirt. Celeb dies? Make a shirt. It is a great way to make money!

121. **Freelance writing.** Have a unique ability to pen the written word?

Have a solid grasp of grammar, spelling, and communicating? You could become a freelance writer for newspapers, magazines, or other local periodicals. THAT could help you make extra cash! Don't be afraid to endure a lot of "No's" and you'll eventually get that "Yes" that can give you some instant credibility. Don't know where to start? You can find thousands of freelance writing and editing jobs...fresh jobs daily. Check out craigslist, and freelance switch. Also, buy your name as a domain and put up sample articles. It makes it way easier to send everyone to one place than copying and pasting thousands of articles.

122. **Plant maintenance.** Just like people need help taking care of pets, they also need help with plants. Make some extra cash by taking care of house plants and even outdoor gardens while people are on vacation. You could also offer to take care of the plants kept in local offices on more of a long term basis. It is as easy as throwing some food and water into the plant, and doing a little trimming. Easy money.

123. **Teach a language:** Do you speak another language? Do you speak English? Either way, your skills are in demand and will help you make

extra money. People need to learn other languages and non-English speakers need to learn English. Most people prefer to learn a conversational style rather than just conjugate verbs around the dinner table. Who knew just talking and having a conversation could result in earning additional income?

124. **Iron other people's clothes.** People are busy and if you offer to iron their clothes and pick up/drop off at their office, you would set yourself apart from the cleaners. Charge a flat fee per shirt and set drop off/pick up times that you will be there. Make your rounds and pick up , iron, drop off, get paid. Since you are going to them, you can charge more!

125. **Run errands:** This one works great and I am not sure if it is because people are truly busy, or truly lazy. But if you offer your services that you will run their errands so they can spend more time at home with the wife, kids, and dog, they will pay a pretty penny to do that.

126. **Teach Your OWN Class:** Do you have a unique skill or ability? Have you EVER heard someone say to you, "I wish I knew how to do that." The "that" could be building decks, arranging flowers, baking pies, playing the piano, canning food, making jewelry, framing pictures, raising roses, whatever! People will pay to be taught. They will pay even more if you offer to teach their children. Offer to teach them or their

children in their homes and you could earn even more.

127. **Become a “green” consultant:** Do you know how to make those little lifestyle changes that result in a home using less energy? Offer to evaluate someone’s home and make recommendations to help it become more green. You could offer to change their light bulbs to CFL’s or LED’s, install a programmable thermostat, install ceiling fans, or make other recommendations. You could also sell your services to businesses. I bet this will become a very large industry in the next few years. Some people will make a LOT of extra money!

128. **Grow Organic:** Do you love to garden and use organic methods? Depending on how large your harvest may be, you could offer “in season” locally grown, organic vegetables and fresh herbs for sale to a restaurant. Take a basket of your most beautiful vegetables and visit several restaurants. Chefs are always interested in getting the best, the freshest food for their patrons. You could pick them, wash them, and deliver them within the hour. You can’t get much more fresh than that!

129. **Garage Sale/Antique Flip:** This is my favorite thing to do in the whole wide world. As you can tell from this list, I have tried quite a few things in order to make money. The most consistent money I make is from these garage sale/ flea markets. Scour the sales, buy, and resell on

eBay or craigslist. I profit nearly every single time. You start knowing deals. You go to a garage sale and see that one item and your eyes get real big and you get it for nearly nothing. I once bought a near new bike for \$5. Ends up it was a classic, fixed gear bike I ended up selling for \$845. I sold it within 2 hours of picking it up. I made nearly \$400 an hour. I don't know if I will ever get close to that ever again!

130. **Set up people's electronics:** Set up computers, home theater systems, or wireless networking systems for the technologically challenged. Even though technology is a constant presence in our everyday lives, some people just can't seem to get the hang of it. You can offer to come in and help those with new gadgets get them set up, install new programs, organize the spaghetti mess of cables, and make sure everything is plugged in correctly.

131. **Clean Up Computers:** A year or so after you've set up those computers, offer to help clean and speed up computers that may have been infected with viruses, malware and spyware. You know it's going to happen and someone will get paid to clean those systems.

132. **Keep People's Tech Up To Date:** If you're really on the technology band wagon, you could offer to help people change the formats of their media. Changing VHS videos to DVDs, scanning old photos, moving

CDs to MP3s, or other format changes can make you some additional income.

133. **Make jams and jellies.** If you listened to your grandma and learned to can and preserve food the old fashioned way, a quick trip to the farmer's market could result in you making a big batch of peach preserves, blackberry jelly, or strawberry jam. Then you could sell it for a profit at a local market or over the Internet.

134. **Photography.** Do you have one of those fancy cameras? Know how to use it? You could potentially start photographing people's children, their weddings, their anniversaries, or their parties. You could take interesting photographs, post them on the appropriate sites, and then make money every time someone uses your photograph. All it takes is a quite lesson on photography, photoshop and you have a full blown business.

135. **Delivering pizzas:** If you have a car and a decent driving record, then you qualify for this easy extra-money maker. You're likely to get some free pizzas, too.

136. **Waiting tables:** This is the perfect job for nights and weekends. That's when all the big tips are made anyway. Pick the nicest place in town.

137. **Bartending:** Even better, I think, than waiting tables is tending bar at nights in a busy bar -- typically at least \$1 for every drink you serve.
138. **Teaching swimming lessons:** If you're a good swimmer, you might be able to pick up a weekend swim-teacher gig at your local recreation center. Keep in mind that some places may require a special certification or that you be a lifeguard.
139. **Car valet:** If you hook up with a for-hire car-parking service (the type hired out for fancy neighborhood parties) you can make some nice cash tips in just a few hours at night and on the weekend, when parties are held.
140. **Design Web logos:** If you're good with Photoshop and can work quickly, you could make some decent cash with this online business.
141. **Rewrite poorly written ads:** Search the ad listings at eBay and Craigslist for big items like cars. E-mail the seller and offer to rewrite the ad for a 1% commission.
142. **Write reviews:** Many Web sites will pay you a little cash to write product reviews. If you're knowledgeable and can write fast, this may work for you.
143. **CashCrate:** There's some money to be made with [CashCrate](#) by completing the free offers, but the real cash comes from the referral

program.

144. **Freebie trading:** Freebie trading is a real moneymaker. But it takes a special person to master the techniques and be consistent with the process. There was a book called “red paper clip” or something like that where some guy took a red paperclip and traded it for something, then traded that item for something all the way up until he got a HOUSE!
145. **Freelance writer:** Right now Elance.com is looking for more writers. Set up an ad and start offering up your fast writing skills.
146. **Sell yourself online (I Wear Your Shirt).** Get creative and sell you and your time online in a fresh, new way.
147. **Sell micro ad space online:** Start a Web site and sell tiny ads. Can this be duplicated? Or can you take the concept and make it fresh?
148. **Start an online store:** Setting up an online store is extremely easy with sites like Amazon, eBay and CafePress. Once you learn how to market that site, you can begin making some cash.
149. **Focus group participant:** Researchers need people to help them develop their results. Become a member of a focus group in your area and get your share of their research funding. Call your local university or museum, or look in your local paper for opportunities.
150. **Sell bottled water or Gatorade:** Buy bottled water in bulk and sell it

for a dollar where there are a ton of people -- parks, festivals, concerts, etc.

151. **Have a car wash:** Find a business that's willing to loan you its parking lot and gather up a few friends to wash some cars. Take donations or ask for very little. People usually do this to raise funds for an organization, but there's no reason you couldn't do it for the You Foundation.
152. **Rent out your truck or van:** If I had a truck and needed extra money, this is one of the ways I would do it. Nothing seems much easier to me.
153. **Drive people to the airport:** Another good gig for someone with a reliable car and the ability to be on time all the time. Once you have a few happy clients and word gets out, you'll find you have to turn business away.
154. **Become a ticket broker:** No special permit required. If you know sports or entertainment enough to pick the right events, and have access to purchase the tickets at face or below, then you can use a service like Stub Hub or Craigslist to resell the tickets for a profit. I've done this both out of necessity and just to make some extra money.
155. **Paper route:** This job will likely take up only your early-morning hours. You can also search for a paper that comes out only once a week.

156. **Play music in church or at weddings:** Some churches don't have volunteers for their music. A talented pianist can make pretty good money doing this on the weekends. My brother is a killer guitar player and he freelances his time every Sunday to different churches not only to play, but also to lead their music.
157. **Sign in the yard.** In our neighborhood we've seen this service hired out for announcements or funny pranks. Ha!
158. **Stage homes.** People are having trouble selling their homes these days and could use a second pair of eyes to stage their home for the quick sale. If you've got the designing skills, offer up your services.
159. **Sign up with Upromise:** Upromise puts money in your kids' college funds while you do your normal spending.
160. **eBay arbitrage:** Find items that you know are selling below their full value (either online or through a deal Web site like Slickdeals), buy them and sell them on eBay for more. Once you find your product niche, you can set up a system.
161. **Resell computers:** This is slightly different than eBay arbitrage. Find a distributor that will sell to you at discounted prices. List these items online. Buy and ship to your heart's content. Basically, you become a reseller.

162. **Craigslist Gigs:** Look for odd jobs on Craigslist. People in your town need your help and they will pay you for it. Seriously. The jobs are there on Craigslist.
163. **Have a garage sale.** The stuff you can't sell online, you could sell from your garage on the weekends. Gather up your neighbors, post ads on craigslist about your garage sale and have everyone pitch in. Live on a cul-de-sac? Have a block party garage sale with every house having a garage sale on the same day.
164. **Put stuff on consignment:** This is great for clothes and other items that aren't easily sold online. How consignment works is you give your item to a store and you don't get paid until it gets sold. But you don't have to worry about trying to sell it.
165. **Bank account-opening bonuses.** Many banks will give you a cash bonus to open an account with them. I'd start with a bank that will pay you higher interest.
166. **Credit card bonuses:** Like the bank accounts, many credit cards will give you bonus cash for opening an account.
167. **Paint street numbers:** With just a few paint and stencil supplies, you could walk the neighborhoods with curbs and solicit your curb-number-painting

168. **Multi Level Marketing:** Join a direct selling company Direct selling is one of the easiest ways to earn some extra cash, especially if you sell products you love. Avon, for example, allows you start your own business for \$10 -- your take home depends on your efforts. Some full-time representatives earn six-figure salaries, others own licensed Avon Beauty Centers and many just sell Avon part time around their family's schedules. Haizel MacIntyre started her Avon business in June of 2008 to earn supplemental income to her full-time job when her husband was laid off. Since joining Avon, MacIntyre averages \$1,800 a month in sales and her husband is helping her run the business. Her Avon earnings help pay the bills, provide extras for her three kids and she is hoping to earn enough to put towards her college tuition when she goes back to school to get her Masters in Social Work.
169. **Launch a brand.** When Kimberly Seals-Allers, former senior editor at Essence magazine, was expecting her first child, she discovered that black women face higher risks during childbirth and pregnancy. "I realized we were a special group, and I wanted to write a book about everything in black women's lives. Not just pregnancy, but money, men, and myths in our community... [I wanted] to create a new way forward." Her first book, *The Mocha Manual to a Fabulous Pregnancy*, turned into

a series (the next book, *The Mocha Manual to Turning Your Passion Into Profit*, is out this month) as well as an online magazine, maternity line, and consultancy. Seals-Allers also licensed use of the *Mocha Manual* name to create an instructional DVD that's sold at Wal-Mart and supermarkets. Seals-Allers, who started working on the *Mocha Manual* concept before leaving her full-time magazine job, says one of the hardest parts was giving up that regular paycheck. "I had a great job, but I wanted something more for my life," she says. One of the biggest misconceptions about going solo, she says, is that it provides more leisure time. "You will work harder than ever before, but it's more rewarding because it's for yourself," she says.

170. **Write for another website.** You can earn about \$1,500 a month by writing articles for eHow.com, a site that posts contributions and then shares revenues from online ads with the writers. You can write about personal finance, nutrition, and careers. Building up enough traffic to earn as much as O'Brien can take time; some newcomers earn just a few dollars a month when they start out.

171. **ChaCha-**Answer questions via text message

172. **Ask for a raise** -- Your job is your most important financial asset and using it to make more money represents the low-lying fruit of all money

making opportunities. Of course you simply can't demand a raise for showing up. You have to ask for a raise in a way that maximizes your likelihood of getting one. Fortunately it's rather simple: do a great job, make sure others know about your success (especially your boss), then pitch the proper person on why you deserve a raise. If you do these things better than most, you can secure a 5-7% raise while the others are stuck with a cost-of-living adjustment. Also note, it's just as important to NOT do certain things when asking for a raise. Otherwise, you might torpedo your chances for the extra loot.

173. **Get a promotion** -- Ok, let's say you're squeamish about asking for a raise -- how about earning a raise by getting a promotion? It's generally accepted that if you have more responsibility you get paid more. But how do you go about getting a promotion? Basically it's the same way you go about building your case to get a raise -- perform well and make sure everyone knows about it. (Plus you can go "above and beyond" most others by doing things like taking professional classes to enhance your marketability.) Since this tip is dependent on the fact that a position actually opens up in your company, it's not quite as good as asking for a raise in my opinion.

174. **Change jobs** -- Just like it's usually the case that you'll earn more

when you get a promotion, most people earn more money when they change jobs (either a lateral change that earns you more or a promotion via job change.) The key here is to market yourself correctly in the job hunt process so you can actually land a job that pays significantly more than your current position. Some job-hunting success tips: make the most of your cover letters, stick with a classic resume that highlights significant job accomplishments, and make the most of your interviews (which includes not asking stupid questions). I've applied these principles several times and I've averaged roughly 13% increases when I've made a move. A couple other tips that are important when it comes to changing jobs: Don't quit your job before you get another one. Quitting without another job is not a good idea and by doing so you're risking your most important financial asset. Believe me, I've seen the disaster. If you're stuck in a job you hate, take specific steps to get out of it, but don't quit without another position lined up. Once you do get a job offer, ask for more money before you accept the position. Doing so can pay off big, netting you \$1,000 a minute. Not a bad return, huh?

175. **Turn your hobby into an extra income** -- How would you like to do something you love and make some extra money at the same time? Then consider turning your hobby into an extra income. This could be anything

from starting your own website to monetizing your artistic penchant to launching your own blog to creating crafts to whatever. I've done this with my hobby of writing. I've sold somewhere around 160 financial and business/marketing articles in the past ten years, earning me around \$60,000 total. In addition, I started this blog on the same topic and it now generates a substantial amount of money (though I give away all the proceeds to charity). I have friends who've done the following: turned their love of cycling into a part-time job of repairing and maintaining bikes, turned their love of hunting and art into making decorative hunting knives that sell nicely at flea markets, and turning their love of baking into a side business selling high-end cookware. Is there something you love doing that could earn you some extra money?

176. **Start a side business** -- Ok, let's say you have a hobby like growing roses or playing video games -- something that may not lend itself easily to making extra money. Instead, you could start a side business (here are some additional tips) of something totally different. Not something you love doing, but not something you hate either. A few examples of what you could do: Take a job no one else wants to do (can you say "pooper scooper?") Become a lifestyle manager-Advise college-bound students-Stage homes-Start a sign-in-the-yard business-Take pictures or play

music-There are literally all sorts of things you could do (including selling your blood -- admittedly it's not a "business", but I just had to throw in this idea to show how some people are so creative when it comes to making money)Or, if you don't feel like you're able to start your own business, maybe you could buy an existing business.

177. **Maximize your investments** -- At first blush, it may not seem like there's a lot of extra income potential in earning an additional percentage or two on your investments. Over the short-term, there isn't. However, when time and compounding are considered, eeking out even an extra 1% could mean thousands of extra dollars for you. Personally, I like index funds because they beat most investments in the long term and take a minimal amount of time to manage. Combine them with the proper asset allocation and regular rebalancing of your portfolio and you're on your way to earning a good bit more from your investments.

178. **Trade/barter skills** -- This is a new one for me, but one that I've had a bit of success with. For instance, I've exchanged marketing advice for some legal counsel. Maybe you're a carpenter who can build something for a plumber who can fix your clogged sink. Or maybe you're a dentist who can offer free cleanings to a veterinarian in exchange for free pet visits. Or perhaps you could design a website for a chiropractor who

could give you free adjustments. Or maybe you can offer dance lessons in exchange for someone tutoring your child. The possibilities are almost endless. Yeah, this option doesn't put cash into your pocket, but it does save you money on something you need to have done. And it could serve as a launching point for your own new business -- you get some experience providing services for others and maybe you'll be able to sell some of those services to people who can't trade but would be willing to buy what you have to offer.

179. **Use your current job skills** -- Take what you do in your current job and consider selling those skills to others at night. If you don't like this option, consider teaching what you know to others. Simply take what you do 40-plus hours a week and extend it into a new business/side income.
180. **Use credit cards strategically** -- In 2006 I earned almost \$500 simply by charging purchases on a cash back credit card. My 2007 results aren't in yet, but I'll be way over this amount. Why? Because I picked the right card for my spending habits (which is THE key to making the most with credit cards) and charged as much as I could on it (including creative ideas like buying gift cards strategically.) In 2008, I'm planning on earning even more by using a hybrid cash back credit card method to earn upwards of 2.6% on my charges by combining uses of the Blue Cash

from American Express card and the Chase Freedom Cash Visa Card.

Eventually I hope to earn in the high three figures simply for doing what I'd normally do -- buying what I'd normally buy. You can do the same.

181. **Get money owed to you** -- As I've noted before, there are billions of dollars in abandoned and lost checking accounts, pensions, and so forth collected by governments. You should see if any of it is yours. I'm a pretty good money watcher, but when I went to Missing Money I found that I had a claim (for "under \$100") from a past job. Sure, it's not a ton of money, but someone out there is likely due a significant sum. Since it takes about one minute to check and see if it's you, what's the harm?

182. **Virtual Farming** - Nearly half a million people in China are making money by playing a game, earning gold and selling it to other players with too much time on their hands and a credit card burning in their pocket! The phenomenon that is World of Warcraft, a massively multi-player online role playing game, has spawned some of the most creative ideas for making money. The game's currency is gold, but a lot of players don't want to take the time to earn it themselves. So, these people in China, and all over the world, spend their days playing the game, making gold and selling it in the game for actual cash.

183. **Online Ideas Go Viral. IE Doggles** - If there is one thing dogs don't

need, it's a pair of goggles, but this idea, which got its start online, has made millions of dollars and real stores have opened up all over the world. They took their original idea, of UV protective goggles and continued expanding their product line to include vests, other eyewear and even jewelry. People will spend countless dollars on their pets and this site more than proves it can pay off big time if you have a pet related product or idea.

184. **The Million Dollar Homepage** - This is probably the most iconic of all the crazy ideas that have ever been born. This guy decided to set up a site and sell one million pixels for \$1 a piece. He got a huge amount of publicity and ended up making his million dollars. He has since gone on to other money making projects.

185. **Create Myspace Layouts:** This teenage girl who had a flair for the creative set up a site to offer layouts for MySpace and free tutorials. The idea took off and she now gets around 7 million visitors to her website every month. She's managed to land some major advertising contracts and has received offers to buy her site that have exceeded \$1.5 million.

186. **Google AdSense:** If you have a website or a blog, you should definitely sign up for Google AdSense. It's one of the few programs you can truly 'set and forget' – once it's there you don't really need to do

much else with it. But there are ways and means to maximize your income from Google AdSense, and as you get to know more about it you can start to generate a decent income from it that will keep rolling in month after month. It's a true passive income, which is why so many people are using it.

187. **Amazon:** You may not realize it but there are a number of ways you can cash in with Amazon.com. The way you choose as being the best one for you will largely depend on what you are already doing, and that's where this particular blog comes in. By doing this you will find that you can take advantage of the sheer amount of traffic and respectability that this website commands all over the world. It's a lot like eBay in this respect – a lot of the hard work is done for you.

188. **ClickBank:** ClickBank is just about the biggest website on the Internet today as far as affiliates are concerned. If you want to make money online but you don't have a product of your own to promote, what better solution could there be than to promote someone else's in exchange for a slice of the profits? ClickBank is a no brainer if you want to get started on no cash at all, and you have your choice of products to promote as well. It's also a great chance to experiment a little and get to know what niches are profitable and which ones have the best products

that you make the most sales on.

189. **HubPages** Ever heard of [HubPages](#)? Not everyone has, and although it is often compared to Squidoo it doesn't have quite the reach or the outlook that Squidoo has. But it does still give you the chance to make some money online, and if you have some interests you'd like to share with other people then it's worth taking a look and adding it to your overall online portfolio of money making websites.
190. **Squidoo:** Setting up your own website costs money, even if you do it yourself. But free web pages provided by other sites or providers always come with provisos – such as the fact that you can't sell on them. Don't they? Not all of them – in fact, one of the best ones gives you all the tools you need to make a nice income every month. All you need to do is put in the work required.
191. **YouTube:** YouTube is one of those websites that really has taken the Internet by storm. So long as you have the right equipment to shoot a home movie (and it isn't too hard to come by without shelling out loads of cash nowadays) you stand a chance of developing an existing business or starting a new one, purely by signing up to YouTube and putting those movies online. But that doesn't explain what kind of videos you should be making. Well relax, because that is what you are about to find out.
